



You are not sick, You are just pregnant!

Basic lab work is necessary to monitor base line and progression.

First Trimester:

Blood count, RH status, STD's, HIV, and infections status labs in early pregnancy ASAP.
10 weeks + Genetic testing (We use DNA based laboratory that provides both evaluation of genetic disorders and gender).

Second Trimester:

15-20 weeks Additional testing in 2nd trimester for neural tube defects.
25-28 weeks: Gestational diabetes testing and repeat basic labs 25-28 weeks (see "are you too sweet?" a.k.a Gestational Diabetes).

Third Trimester:

36 weeks+ Group B strep bacteria testing - Finish line in view!

Additional lab work as necessary

If you have medical problems or history of pregnancy related conditions this will sometimes require additional lab work.
